Responsibilities:

- Networking on behalf of SHARE to establish relationships (e.g., community and health organizations, colleges, schools, churches, food pantries and shelters) to distribute informational packets within the Chinese communities
- Outreach to community partners and introduce SHARE's services and information packets
- Represent SHARE at public events, communicate SHARE's mission/programs/services and disseminate information regarding, risk factors, screening, symptoms, treatment and survivor stories, In-person or virtual presentations at events as requested
- Deliver educational bilingual presentations in collaboration with our Black and/or Latino Outreach teams
- Track participation and submit reports/feedback to ChineseSHARE Director and ChineseSHARE Outreach Coordinator
- Attend SHARE trainings and meetings as requested
